

HOW IT WORKS:

STEP 1: HOW IT WORKS Line 48 of the AZ140, shows the amount you can contribute as a tax credit. If you file Form 140PY, look at Line 58.

STEP 2: MAKE YOUR CONTRIBUTION Choose the General Scholarship Fund, which serves the schools with the highest unmet need, or select the school(s) of your choice.

- **Mail:** Complete and mail the contribution form

STEP 3: CLAIM YOUR TAX CREDIT USING AZ TAX FORMS 323 AND/OR 348 ON YOUR AZ TAX FILING CEA will mail you a tax receipt immediately following completion of your contribution. Present this to your tax preparer (or use with your personal tax software).

What is the private education tax credit?

Arizona law (ARS43-1089) allows taxpayers to direct all or a portion of their state tax liability to certified School Tuition Organizations (STOs) like Catholic Education Arizona. Your tax dollars are used exclusively for tuition scholarships for underserved children.

Did you know that you can DOUBLE the impact of your tax credit contribution at no additional cost to you?

Many employers match tax credit contributions made by their employees and retirees. To see if your employer participates, visit the Matching Gift Opportunities page on our website.

Can I take multiple tax credits (private education, public school, qualifying charitable, foster care)?

Absolutely! You can participate in multiple tax credit programs up to the extent of your state tax liability. Remember, if you end up contributing more than your tax liability this year, you can carry over the excess for up to 5 tax years.
